Announcements from the Chair *Becky Porter*

- **Summer Undergraduate Admissions**

- **Beginners**
 - Admits - 27 -18.6%
- **Transfers**
 - Admits + 53 +11.0%

- **Fall Undergraduate Admissions**

- **Beginners**
 - Admits + 855 +24.9%
- **Transfers**
 - Admits + 57 +10.0%

- **Fall Comments**

- Except for Native Americans, all minority admits are up in absolute numbers, but are down as a percentage of the total number of admits
- Conditional beginner admits are up 247 (31%)
 - We will continue to see an increase in conditional admits because less qualified students tend to apply during this time period. While we have an increase in conditional admits, it is important to note that we also have an increase in fully qualified admits of 554 fully qualified admits.
- We have processed 353 Intercampus transfer students and admitted 288
- We have processed 329 returning students and admitted 278
 - As the admission process for these groups changed last Spring, we do not have comparable data from Fall 2006
- Information about quality of Fall 2007 admits *see below*
 - The drop in the SAT score may be due to the increased number of applicants or due to the increased number of conditional admits
 - The increase in the number of conditional admits reflects the change in processing individuals who previously would have been held for spring semester grades so that these individuals could be invited to participate in the summer bridge program.

- Undergraduate**

- Pace of undergraduate application intake has picked up considerably over the past month, and we are now even with last year [in December, applications were 45% behind Fall 06]
 - Number of admits expected to catch up over next few weeks

- Graduate**

- Graduate applications for Fall 07 are approximately even overall (PhD up, master's & professional down slightly), with admits overall running 8.9% behind last year

- The decline in Fall activity is more than made up by an increase in Summer apps and admits, mostly master's & non-degree.

- **Director of Undergraduate Admissions Search**
 - The position was advertised through the *Chronicle of Higher Education* and appropriate professional associations over the last month. As of early this week, 24 applications have been received. The search committee has been appointed and review of applications will begin soon.
- **Campus Day**
 - Campus Day was held Sunday, March 4th. Preliminary figures indicate that undergraduate prospective student attendance increased by approximately 100 individuals compared to last spring. This figure does not include family members attending with the student. All who were crowded into the hallways are looking forward to next spring when the even will be in the Campus Center.
- **Financial Aid Packaging**
 - Student Financial Aid Services met their target date for initial distribution of aid notifications to Fall 2007 freshmen. Over 960 notifications were mailed on March 16th. This early notification is important in our recruiting efforts.
 - They will begin packaging aid for returning/continuing students June 1st.
- **Summer and Fall Registration**
 - Priority Registration began Monday, March 19 and continues through Friday, March 30, 2007. Enrollment reports will be made available through the Point-in-Cycle and Registrar's Websites once the priority registration period is finished—sometime in the beginning of April.
- **Retention Studies Presentation**
 - Gary Pike and Vic Borden have completed major new research projects on retention on our campus. They will be presenting their findings on Thursday, April 19, at 10:00 am till noon in BS2000. The title for the presentation is "A Summary of IUPUI Student Retention Studies." The retention report information prepared by Derek Price last fall will be included as we seek better understanding of IUPUI student success.

- **Other announcements**
 - Marilyn Irwin announced that SLIS will have a Fulbright Scholar from Mongolia
 - Doug Lees announced that a Biology student has been accepted to Harvard Medical School with a full scholarship

Enrollment Trends at IU Campuses 1997-2006 *Ty Cruce and Victor Borden* (University Reporting and Research)

- A few highlights from the presentation
 - Undergraduate degree-seeking enrollment has decreased 4% since 2003
 - Nondegree enrollment (UG + grad) has decreased 30% since 2001
 - Total degree enrollments have increased 15% since 1997
 - If an individual does not have some college by age 25, there is a marked decrease in the likelihood that the individual will attend college
 - Masters degree enrollment has increased 123% since 1997
 - Doctoral degree enrollment has increased 76% since 2002
 - Since 2003, IUPUI has had a larger total (i.e., including non-degree) graduate/professional enrollment than IUB
