3. **(88 Acct)** IPS Student Scholarship: \$36,622.88 (market value increase: \$1,085.38, Investment Income \$139.45, Contributions \$00)

4. **(52 Acct)** SA Fund: \$ **5,727.80** (market value increase: \$190.68,

Investment income \$24.50, Contributions \$00)
