Because of unavoidable and unexpected complications, University President John W. Ryan and Chancellor Maynard K. Hine have been forced to postpone the reception for new IUPUI faculty from October 1 until October 8. The reception is still scheduled for the Union Building and the times indicated on the invitations mailed to faculty will still be observed -- but the date has been changed from October 1 until October 8.

The trustees of Indiana University and Purdue University have approved the realignment of Downtown Campus and 38th Street Campus departments into three IUPUI units: a school of liberal arts, a school of science, and a school of engineering and technology.

The alignment completes the academic integration program which was begun with the merger of the Indiana University and Purdue University programs four years ago. The new academic organization reflects the missions assigned to IUPUI through the merger and places the academic departments of both I.U. and Purdue in an appropriate structure.

The plan for realignment, completed after considerable consultation with the faculty and academic administrations of IUPUI, was approved by the Chancellor's Advisory Committee before it was sent to the Purdue and I.U. boards of trustees.
