Indiana Campus Compact will host the Service Engagement Summit 2.0, their 2nd Annual Service Engagement Summit, March 29-30, 2012. The gathering will take place in Indianapolis at the Marriott North and will highlight emerging trends in service engagement in higher education. This two day event will provide opportunities for college and university administrators, faculty, staff, students, and their community partners to interact with local, state, and national leaders in service and higher education, an awards reception and ceremony, and interactive workshops will address engagement between higher education campuses and their communities.
