The IUPUI Center for Service and Learning is pleased to support the 2012 IUPUI Civic Engagement Showcase and Symposium (CESS). This year's event willfeature informative workshops, poster presentations, networking opportunities and an awards recognition program for all who are involved in civic engagement work, including community partners, faculty, staff and students. In addition to the popular celebration of the William M. Plater Civic Engagement Medallion recipients, this year's CESS also includes several workshops developed specifically for community partners and faculty/staff. For community members who are just embarking on relationships with IUPUI faculty, staff or students, "An Introduction to Navigating Campus Resources" workshop will feature a panel representing key resources in order to better connect with IUPUI. The workshop, "Building Relationships for Strategic Project Development" is geared primarily for those community partners and faculty/staff who have engaged in past civic work and are looking to explore new possibilities. All CESS attendees are also invited to learn more about using technology to enhance civic learning at the workshop, "An Untapped Resource: Using Technology to Demonstrate Impact."



Poster presentations will occur in two 45-minute sessions and will feature posters submitted by faculty, graduate and undergraduate students and community partners. Over 40 posters will highlight a broad array of activities in community-engaged teaching, research and service. The CESS formal program will include remarks from Dean Uday Sukhatme, Vice Chancellor and Dean of the Faculties, as well as recognition of IUPUI community partners, student scholarship recipients, and faculty/staff civic engagement award winners. The program concludes with the awarding of the 2012 Plater Civic Engagement Medallions, which recognizes the accomplishments of graduating students who have shown ongoing commitment to their communities.
