[I. Minevich] Hello, my name is Igor Minevich and I'm a math major at IUPUI.

--What do you enjoy about Math?--

[I. Minevich] Well, I like mathematics because of a lot of things, really: it improves your problem-solving ability, it challenges you, and I love challenges. The Math Department at IUPUI is excellent. I came here first to do Biomedical Engineering because I thought it was great, but actually, math, I think, is even better. We have great professors here. We have two professors who won the International Mathematical Olympiad in high school, so they were number one in the world, basically, which is pretty impressive in itself.

--How are you involved on campus?--

[I. Minevich] I really like sharing my passion for mathematics. I really like it when I can teach somebody something extra that they don't learn in class. I'm a tutor at the Math Assistance Center. If I can actually talk to one person for about 20 or 30 minutes, and I can actually explain the material well, maybe show them an application of it, show them an extension of it, get them interested in it, then I really have a lot of fun.
