MORE THAN 165 REGISTRANTS, a record number, took part in the Sixth Annual Teaching Conference of the Dental School, Dr. James R. Roche, Chairman of the Teaching Committee, reports. An added feature of this year's meeting was the presentation of informal comments from the following six students who attended the Conference as representatives of their classes: Gary S. Gritzbaugh, sophomore; E. Kent Fritch, junior; Philip R. Mallatt, senior; Shanon Richey, Dental Hygiene (Fort Wayne); Maria Voskuil, Dental Hygiene (South Bend); and Sheila Berger, Dental Hygiene (Medical Center Campus).

APPROXIMATELY 50 PER CENT of the 1970 graduates of the Dental School headed directly into private practice, a recent survey shows.

Twenty per cent will continue their studies in graduate school or as interns. Thirty per cent will enter the Federal service, with the Army attracting the greatest number, followed by the Navy, Air Force, and Public Health Service.

THIRTY-FOUR SENIORS received various citations and awards at the annual recognition dinner last June. Winner of the \$100 Block Drug Co. award for the best senior essay was Dr. Lee Allen, now in general practice in Seattle.

Michael L. Freid won first place in the Table Clinic contest for juniors. His prize will be a trip to the ADA annual meeting in Las Vegas in November.

CONGRATULATIONS ARE ALSO DUE to Dr. Stephen Troyer, senior resident in Oral Surgery, who has achieved national recognition for his paper entitled "Ankylosis of the Coronoid Process of the Mandible to the Zygomatic Arch Subsequent to the Surgical Correction of Prognathism: a Case Report". He has been invited to read the paper this fall at meetings of the American Society of Oral Surgeons in Miami, and the American Association of Hospital Dentists in Las Vegas.
