Dear Graduate Affairs Committee,

The School of Informatics and Computing, IUPUI, proposes to amend the admissions requirements for the following degree program:

Master of Library Science

The current admissions requirements are a Bachelor's degree; minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale; program-specific experience, coursework, and/or portfolio; CV; personal statement; three references; and if minimum GPA requirements are unmet the GRE, General Test. Students whose native language is not English and who have not earned a BS or MS degree in the United States are also required to have taken a TOEFL Test with a minimum score of 100 (iBT) or an IELTS with a minimum score of 6.5. International students are also required to take the GRE, General Test.

For international students who wish to complete this 100% online degree abroad and, thus, do not require a visa, the school would require a minimum TOEFL score of 100 (iBT) or IELTS score of 7.5 and waive the English for Academic Purposes (EAP) placement testing requirement.
