THE FOLLOWING ITEM FROM THE Indianapolis News for July 11, 1972, will be of interest to the many friends of Dr. Richard A. Misselhorn, Professor Emeritus of Oral Diagnosis/Oral Medicine:

Volumes have been written about the psychological impact that follows retirement from a job, but some rewriting may be necessary because of Dr. Richard A. Misselhorn.

The Kendallville native joined the faculty of the School of Dentistry at Indiana-Purdue University, Indianapolis, in 1941, as a part-time instructor. He became a full-time faculty member five years ago after he retired from his private dental practice.

When he hung up his professor's gown this year, after instructing thousands of students in oral diagnosis and oral medicine, the university's board of trustees awarded him an emeritus title.

For most men, this would have signaled a time when their usefulness was diminished, if not over.

But Dr. Misselhorn and his wife were visiting recently in a small town outside Hamilton, Ohio, when an accident occurred outside the building they were in. Dr. Misselhorn pulled a small girl from the wrecked car and held her carotid artery 25 minutes, preventing her from bleeding to death.

Said a woman at the accident scene: "God put him in that place, at that time, just for that purpose."

SHIRLEY SHAZER, OF THE DEPARTMENT OF Oral Diagnosis/Oral Medicine, returned August 30 from a trip to the Scandinavian countries which included a nostalgic visit to the research laboratory in Bergen, Norway, where she worked on a special assignment for two months in 1967. During a stopover in Stockholm, Shirley visited Dr. Ed Shields, a 1970 IUSD graduate, who is working on his Ph. D, at the Institute of Medical Genetics. That is the place where Dr. David Bixler carried on research in 1968-69 and again last summer. Shirley spent four days in Stockholm before going on to Bergen for a reunion with her former colleagues at the Gades Institute of Pathology of the University of Bergen. Among those she visited was Dr. Gisle Bang, who served as a visiting professor some time ago at the School of Dentistry here.
