Dr. Greg Arling Joins IU Geriatrics

Gregory W. Arling, PhD, joined IU Geriatrics and the IU Center for Aging Research as a Center Scientist in August of 2006. Dr. Arling also has an appointment as visiting associate professor in the School of Public & Environmental Affairs at IUPUI.

He currently is working with Dr. Steve Counsell in two areas: 1) analysis of the GRACE clinical trial results as a member of the GRACE Research Team, and 2) development of care management and nursing facility transition programs for the State of Indiana as a member of the Medicaid Medical Advisory Cabinet.
