Meeting on September 13, 1917.

Present: Franklin Vonnegut, Scherer, Pantzer, Lieber, Rath, Stempfel and Westing.

Dean Rath reported there are 17 returning male and 24 female students of last year's class, in addition 10 men and 31 women have registered as new students this year so the entire class count is 82, 27 men and 55 women.

A request from Frank J. Tracy to be granted tuition payment extension until after graduation was answered as follows: the Board of Trustees is ready to accept his promissory notes provided acceptable guarantee.

Decided to increase the janitor's wages with \$2/week.

We were saddened to hear about the death of former teacher Dr. John E. Mortis.

Decided to recommend to the students to acquire a group policy accident insurance.

The treasurer submitted a report about estimated income and expenses of the ~~Sen~~ dormitory.

From it, it is clear that frugal management is necessary.

Decided to increase Dean Rath's salary ~~with~~ to \$3,600 per year and secretary Steichmann's to \$800 per year.
