



INDIANA UNIVERSITY BLOOMINGTON PRESIDENT





This chart represents a structure for the Indiana University Bloomington Provost's Office. Officers on this page are assumed to have primary responsibilities for IU Bloomington with the exception of the Associate Vice President and Dean of the Graduate School (which is a system-level organization) and the Associate Vice President/Director of SES (which includes the system-wide PeopleSoft enterprise.) Some deans and directors may have responsibilities over academic programs on other campuses altough these are yet to be determined.
