FFA GOVERNING COMMITTEE

September 3, 1975

The meeting of the FFA Governing Committee was conducted by telephone on September 3, 1975, by H. N. Hunsicker, Chairman. Persons participating included H. E. Edwards, Byron F. Rawls and Wm. Paul Gray.

Prior to the Governing Committee meeting, State staff members from Mississippi, Pennsylvania and Tennessee called the National FFA Office stating the individuals from their States were not officially listed as paid up members, therefore, were ineligible for the American Farmer Degree.
