The members of the 2010-2011 School of Liberal Arts Promotion and Tenure Committee were as follows: Gabrielle Bersier (WLAC-Chair), David Bodenhamer (HIST), Gregory Keller (PHIL), Lynn Pike (SOC), Thomas Upton (ENG), Peter Rangazas (Campus Committee Rep.-ECON), Rick Bein (GEOG) and Francia Kissel (ENG).

The committee convened to review six cases in the fall semester of 2010: two candidatures for tenure and promotion to the rank of Associate Professor, one Associate Professor candidate for tenure, and three candidatures for promotion from Associate to Full Professor rank. One additional candidate with split appointments in the School of Education and the School of Liberal Arts was reviewed separately. There were no lecturer candidates for promotion to Senior Lecturer this year.

All candidates were recommended for promotion and/or tenure.

At this point, letters from Chancellor Bantz communicating recommendation by IU President McRobbie for positive decision on all these candidates have been sent out. The Board of Trustees is expected to review the recommendations on April 14-15.

In the spring semester of 2011, the committee is convening to conduct three third-year reviews.
