INDIANA UNIVERSITY BUDGET REQUEST

In our issue of October 10, 1975 we printed the campus-by-campus budget request for 1976-77. That request has now been updated to include actual enrollment increases. The new request has been supplied to the Higher Education Commission and the State Budget Agency. It shows a 4.6 per cent increase for IUPUI non-health over the previous request. Campus-by-campus requests are shown in the following table in millions of dollars.
