IUPUI Sets Spring Enrollment Record

A record number of students enrolled at IUPUI this semester compared to previous Spring semesters. Not only that, students also are taking a record number of credit hours, new data revealed.

Spring enrollment reached 29,197 students taking 333,872 credit hours. This topped the 2009 Spring record of 29,126 students.

2011 also marks six consecutive years for a new record being set for the amount of credit hours taken at IUPUI. This semester saw an increase of 1.9 percent.
