Tobacco (A more detailed list of consequences compiled by Miranda Spitznagle can be forwarded upon request)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Lung Cancer</li> <li>○ Lung Disease</li> <li>○ Oral/Throat Cancer</li> <li>○ Cardiovascular disease</li> <li>○ Lower infant birth weight</li> <li>○ Abuse/dependence</li> <li>○ Risky sexual behavior (youth/teens)/gateway to premarital/teen sex</li> <li>○ 9,700 deaths annually</li> <li>○ 14 year reduction in life expectancy</li> <li>○ Abdominal aortic aneurysm, acute myeloid leukemia, cataracts, cervical cancer, kidney cancer, pancreatic cancer, pneumonia, periodontitis, and stomach cancer, peptic ulcers, erectile dysfunction.</li> <li>○ For newborns see lower birth weight, poorer lung function, higher incidence of SIDS. Mothers can experience many issues during pregnancy and have a harder time becoming pregnant.</li> <li>○ Second hand smoke also associated with higher increase in health problems including cancer, problem pregnancies, asthma, cardiovascular disease, etc.</li> </ul>	Retailers cited for sales to minors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Sales to minors</li> <li>○ Financial problems</li> <li>○ \$236 million to US due to second hand smoke-related asthma. Costs Indiana \$9 million.</li> <li>○ Exposure of children to second hand smoke</li> <li>○ Increased absences from work and longer illnesses for smokers</li> <li>○ Smokers incur higher medical costs for employers</li> <li>○ Smoking increases likelihood that teens will try other drugs.</li> <li>○ Increased risky behavior such as fighting and engaging in unprotected sex.</li> <li>○ \$448 million of all Indiana Medicaid expenditures are related to smoking</li> <li>○</li> </ul>
Marijuana	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Potentially same as tobacco but insufficient data exist</li> <li>○ Abuse/dependence</li> <li>○ Risky sexual behavior/gateway to premarital/teen sex (youth/teens)</li> <li>○ Increase unwanted pregnancy/STD transmission</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Drug related property crime (burglary, larceny, etc.)</li> <li>○ Other crimes related to gaining money for drugs (e.g., prostitution)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Use correlated with higher rates of “harder” drug use</li> <li>○ Use correlated with higher use of tobacco</li> <li>○ Drug-related school drop out</li> <li>○ Academic failure (youth)</li> <li>○ Absenteeism-work</li> <li>○ Absenteeism-school</li> <li>○ Interpersonal conflicts (arguments, family issues)</li> <li>○ School expulsion for use at school</li> <li>○ Financial problems</li> <li>○ Poor parenting</li> <li>○ Incarceration of parents</li> <li>○ Kids placed in “system”</li> </ul>
