## Kelley School of Business Evening MBA Policy Committee Minutes 2/21/2007

- 1. January minutes were not available at the time of the meeting.
- 2. New course proposals from John Galvin for revamping of S555 and S556 courses were discussed and the committee unanimously passed the following changes in the Evening MBA Core:

The Evening MBA Policy Committee hereby approves reduction of the information systems core requirement from 3.0 hours to 1.5 hours. *S555 Managing in the Information Age: the Strategic Use of IT in Business* (1.5 hours) remains as a required course and *S556 Managing in the Information Age: Delivering IT Solutions in Support of Business Goals* (1.5 hours) becomes an elective and is no longer a required course.

- 3. The committee informally endorsed the idea that stressing the program's attachment to the school's MBA portfolio is more productive in terms of marketing than stressing the program's geographic attachment to Kelley Indianapolis. The September and February Open Houses/Info Sessions will be sponsored by the Evening Program while Kelley Direct will sponsor May and November sessions.
- 4. As of now, we can only say 24 credit hours of the core are offered at Kelley Carmel. In order to officially offer more than 50% of the program at a satellite location, approval must come from the Indiana Commission on Higher Education. The Office of the Deans is mulling over how to proceed.
