In May 2011 the Center for Service and Learning (CSL) and Indiana Campus Compact (ICC) co-hosted a Service Learning Institute and IUPUI Research Academy. Workshops during the first half of this week-long event focused on helping faculty infuse service learning pedagogy into course syllabi, identify ways to engage community partners as co-educators, and connect with others using service learning to generate new ideas for teaching.
