Faculty panel votes for 'FX' option to be continued, with limitations

The Indiana University Faculty Council passed without modification a recommendation from the Educational Policy Committee that the controversial FX policy be retained with new stipulations.

'The passage of this recommendation will be effective system wide," said Patricia Boaz, dean of the school of science at IUPUI, and chairperson of the Faculty Council's Educational Policy Committee.

The FX policy provides that students who received an F in a course can take the course again and have the original grade removed from their permanent university transcript and thus not incorporated into the G.P.A.

Faculty on the IU Bloomington campus objected to the policy, claiming students were abusing it. The Bloomington Faculty Council passed a resolution which said. 'The current FX grade should be replaced with the grade of F. Stu-

replaced with the grade of P. Students should be allowed to retake classes in which they have been assigned an F. But both gradeshould be calculated into the G.P.A."

System-wide reaction to the Bloomington resolution was mixed. While two regional campuses favored elimination of the FX policy, the Indianapolis faculty favored modification rather than elimination of the policy.

The recommendation, passed by the Faculty Council on April 10, places new restrictions and stipulations on use of the option. The council thinks they will eliminate misuse of it.

The new stipulations are as follows:

 The FX option if honored by all undergraduate schools and divisions on all IU campuses.

A student may exercise the FX option in no more than 3 courses, totaling no more than 10 credits.

3. A student may use the FX option only once for a given course.

The revised policy will appear in all university bulletins, class schedules and student handbooks, beginning in the fall.

The new stipulations will "make students be more careful when they choose their courses and set their priorities, if they know that they won't be able to continually use the FX when they become disinterested or just stop coming to class," Boaz said.

"I think we've arrived at a revision that both faculty and students can live with." Boaz said.

SLA appoints new deans as part of reorganization to improve curriculum, academic counseling

William M. Plater, dean of the school of liberal arts, announced last week the appointment of John D. Barlow as associate dean for academic affairs and Sue Kiefer Hammersmith as assistant dean for student affairs.

Associate Dean James East will become associate dean for development and external affairs. He will continue as dean of the Weekend College and director of Learn and Shop.

The newly created positions within the school are subject to the approval of the IU Board of Trustees.

Plater said the appointments of Barlow and Hammersmith are part of a reorganization instituted to improve curriculum and academic

counseling in the SLA.

The programs to assure these improvements have been in place for the past year. However, the organizational structure to oversee these programs was nonexistent

until now," Plater said.

"We're looking to the future, and we will put some resources into this effort to upgrade the school of liberal arts."

Barlow will be responsible for working with the faculty in development and curriculum. He said he is confident that the rapport he has developed with SLA faculty as president of the Faculty Council will assist in his work.

Hammersmith said that implementation of a school-wide counseling service, improvement of departmental academic counseling and better communication with business and civic leaders within the city are of prime importance for the school and students.

Plater concurred with Hammersmith's assessment of priorities.

tain a liberal arts degree."

Plater also announced plans to appoint Helen Henard as an academic counselor for the school. She will coordinate her responsibilities with Hammersmith.

Richard A. Fredland, chairman of the political science department, has been appointed to work parttime to promote, encourage and coordinate school activities in the area of international affairs.

Barlow received a Ph.D. in German from New York University in 1967. He has been associated with IUPUI since that year, beginning as an assistant professor of German.

Hammersmith earned a Ph.D. in anthropology from IU in 1976. She joined the IUPUI faculty as an instructor in sociology in 1976.



A fair 'FX' policy

The Indiana University Faculty Council deserves praise for having voted to continue the "FX" policy, and for its wise alterations of it (story on page 1).

Under the policy, a student may take again a class that he or she failed, and substitute the second grade for the first. The first grade re-mains on the transcript with an "X" denoting its cancellation thence the term 'FX"), but is not figured into the Grade Point Average. The recommended changes will place limits on the number of times a student may use the FX option.

The recommendations of the council — a system-wide faculty organization — run counter to a resolution by the Bloomington Faculty Council. That council resolved that the failing grade be figured into the G.P.A. A student who failed a class one time and earned an "A' the second would have, in effect, a "C" to show for all that work.

The continuance and changes of the policy can be seen as an affort to maintain a measure of "forgiveness" in academic policy while main-

taining academic standards.

No student should pay the permanent penalty of a low G.P.A. for an occasional failure: Having to take a class again is penalty enough After all, the idea of education is not necessarily to do something right the first time. Rather, it is to learn - to master bodies of knowledge and develop habits of thought, and to make them one's own. To pass a class after initial failure is an accomplishment and a redemption of sorts. The G.P.A. should reflect the final success, not the intital

At the same time, the student who fails repeatedly - through lack either of discipline or application or of ability - should suffer the consequences. Repeated failures indicate absence of those traits a diploma is meant to certify

The University Faculty Council's limitations on the FX policy hold the middle ground between extremes of laxity and strictness: They maintain rigor without rigidity.

No easy answers to gov't spending question

Economic realities and political realities are two different entities. The current \$200 billion deficit is a typical example of the paradoxical relationship between economics

This high rate of growth would seem to be a good thing; however, other factors can come to play in the economy, namely the Federal Reserve. Paul Volcker, Fed chairman, is very concerned about the rapid pace of the recovery. Volcker's main concern lies with a threat of renewed inflation. Volcker has stated that in the face of such huge deficits the Fed will follow a tight monetary policy.

This current recovery now un-der way could very possibly be side tracked by huge federal defi-cits. How? The deficit has helped increase an already strong demai for goods and services. Indications show that from the first part of this year the economy is growing at a 6 to 7 percent rate (adjusted for in-

The result of a tight monetary policy would be increased interest rates. Also, don't forget the deficit has to be financed somehow. ere are two ways to finance a deficit: 1. Print more money. 2. The government goes into the private money market and borrows the money.

Where does the answer lie? While everyone in the Congress and the White House says they want to reduce the deficit this year, it seems very unlikely this will oc-cur. Most people believe more will be done about the deficit next year

Which one is correct is not for me to answer but for all of us to answer. Possibly the day has arriv-ed where our unlimited wants can-not be financed by deficit money. — Mark E. Bare

Where's the 'distinction'?

Graduating with distinction in the Indiana University system is a JOKE! According to a policy to be implemented this May, only 10 percent of a graduating class is allowed to graduate with distinction, regardless of the number of students in-that class who have a grade point average above 3.5. Consequently, if a student is a member of a large graduating class with a majority of mediocre students, a grade point average of 3.5 practically insures graduation with distinction. However, should that same student be a member of a small class with many superior fellow students, even a grade point average of 3.7 may not qualify him/her for the honor of distinction," Is it rational thinking that the student's achievement is any less, simply because other class members are also quality students? Individual achievement loses its value under this policy and surely in-

What is the rationale for a policy that bases "distinction" on the nun see of students in a class? Is it pos sible that the bureaucracy of ins tionalized education has once again subjugated the students' best in ests to the interests of the policy makers? (After all, a university wit a reputation for graduating only 10% of its student body with distinc tion may receive higher prestige rut ings.) With the vigorous competi tion among colleges and universi-ties for student enrollment, perhaps individuals student performance and achievement has lost its meaning and value in the IU system. This 10 percent policy is a fine example of the dehumanizing attitude that prevails in this institution of "higher learning".

Much at stake for U.S., world in 1984 presidential election

Spring is here, and with it comes the political primary season. This spring, I find myself reflecting on the power of the U.S. presidency and how crucial its policies are to people not just in the U.S. but across the world. It's a serious responsibility we as citizens have in choosing a person who has so much control over other people's lives.

With this in mind, I've been thinking about our 1980 choice for president and his major policy decisions and actions. These have included

1. Priorities and non-priorities: Ronald Reagan has declared that providing basic human needs and cultural enrichment is not the business of the federal govern-ment, and has slashed federal funding in both areas. He has set as top budget priorities the buildup of

our military capabilities; the stockpiling of weapons systems; and the use of our armed forces as watchdogs for U.S. business interests under the guise of "making the world safe from communism. Another top priority has been initiating legal battles to decide personal ethical and religious questions, such as the right of parents to choose bringing or not bringing children - including disabled ones into the world; and whether prayer and racial discrimination have a place in schools.

2. Administration personnel: He has appointed people to federal offices who have undermined and dismantled policies which took their various departments years to build, including the Environmental Protection Agency, the Departments of Energy and the Interior, and the U.S. Civil Rights Commis-

3. Economic policy: He has developed a tightly-controlled economic policy which has widened the gap between the rich and poor further than it's been since the Depression, while insuring that corporate executives, bankers and

sent troops and weapons to countries such as Grenada and El Salvador, interfering in those countries internal liberation struggles. And he has placed weapons in European countries, threatening the lives of their citizens in the name of defending U.S. lives.

4. International relations: He has used tough language rather than diplomacy with adversaries in international relations and supported right-wing governments consistently and vocally. He has

This has been a long and difficult four years for many of us as we have seen what Ronald Reagan has done with the presidency. I have been heartened recently, though, by this campaign's Demo-cratic debates which are presenting a dialogue on key issues. And I'm glad to see the emergence of Jesse

lackson as a candidate of hope, a representative of minority strength, and a catalyst for discuss ing issues and viewpoints too often ignored by past candidates.

We as a voting public deserve to see not just a media image cam-paign of each presidential can-didate, but an in-depth look at their beliefs, platforms, and ways of handling situations. And we have a presponsibility to let the have a responsibility to let the can-didates know how we feel, by speaking out and writing our views during the campaign; voting in the election; and holding the elected person accountable throughout the next four years. I hope everyone will take the 1984 election seriously and will vote thoughtfully. This time, the stakes are really high.



ROTC cadets tested in mock battlefield exercises






