Alumni News

Dave Mossbarger, MBA '88, now working at the Regenstrief Institute, IU School of Medicine (IUSM), recently appeared as a co-author in two publications. The June issue of the monthly newsletter *Forum* of the Society of General Internal Medicine featured the article, "Changing Organizational Culture," in its Ask the Expert column, which was written by Mossbarger with Thomas Inui, MD, of IUSM. In May, Mossbarger appeared with several others from IUSM as a contributor to a chapter in a newly published book, *Professionalism in Medicine: Critical Perspectives* (Wear and Aultman, eds.). Their chapter, "Educating for Professionalism at Indiana University School of Medicine: Feet on the Ground and Fresh Eyes," discusses means by which medical schools might reinvigorate education for professionalism, describing a culture change project which Mossbarger has coordinated for the past three plus years. This project received coverage in the *Indianapolis Star* on May 16, in *American Medical Association News* in April, and in the *Wall Street Journal* last September.

Jeff Stanger, BA '94, was invited to the NCAA Baseball College World Series this past June for a behind the scenes look at the premier college baseball event. He is working on the sequel to *Trolley Dodgers*, which was released in September 2005. Trolley Dodgers is set in Bloomington and follows the town's efforts to buy the L.A. Dodgers and move them to the Midwest. "It's light-hearted fun...think *Field of Dreams* meets *Waiting for Guffman*," says Stanger. The working title for the sequel is *Roll With It*, and Stanger says Hoosier baseball will get to take center stage in this book. Look for it on bookstore shelves soon!

Dave Johnson, BA '73, was born with cerebral palsy, weighing two pounds, twelve ounces at birth. He recently accepted a post to manage an international banking office in Australia. "I have worked all of my life to overcome other people's attitudes and preconceptions about my disability, and about my abilities. The only limitations that cannot be overcome are the limitations we place on ourselves," says Johnson. Proving that, Johnson is also a Wealth Management Executive, an ordained Christian minister, a Mensan, a motivational speaker, a musician, a poet and a life member of the IUAA.
