
GOVERNING COMMITTEE OF THE FUTURE FARMERS OF AMERICA
Washington, D.C.
Nov. 9, 1965

The meeting of the Governing Committee of the FFA was called to order by H. N. Hunsicker, Chairman. Others present included E. J. Johnson, W. P. Gray (members of the Committee), W. W. Carnes, E. J. Hawkins, John J. Farrar, and John C. Foltz. (Mr. Gray also served as Secretary).

Mr. Hawkins discussed several items pertaining to the Supply Service, one of which was the renewal of the option of the Supply Service for purchasing the Official FFA Jacket and Emblem for two years. It was moved by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Gray and carried, that Mr. Hawkins be granted authority to negotiate on a three year contract with a two year option.

The second item of business pertained to the policy of paying all bills from FFA funds. It was moved by Mr. Gray, seconded by Mr. Johnson and carried, that all bills relative to the national office and Foundation should be certified preferably by two persons in the national office, one of which will definitely be the national advisor, or, in his absence, the person acting as national advisor. It was also agreed that bids for printing should be authorized by the person requesting the bids, subject to approval of the Governing Committee.
