IUSD New Academic Directions – The Journey Begins

This fall, as part of the September Faculty Enrichment program, I presented a <u>comprehensive outline</u> of the background, rationale and opportunities for IUSD to engage in serious planning for our future under the title of New Academic Directions. Following the fall teaching conference, several of you have asked me about the process for the Faculty Council to be actively working on IUSD New Academic Directions—does the faculty prepare something or does the dean? After conferring with the IUSD Faculty Executive Committee, I will be preparing a draft document of IUSD New Academic Directions for in depth review, analysis and approval by the Faculty Council. This will probably happen in a series of presentations to various faculty groups. On January 2nd, I will present a number of structural changes we need to make to enhance the DDS program as well as suggested changes for all other academic programs too. A major focus of this process will be to settle on a consistent and rational method of assessing our outcomes which we can cite to confirm our Vision statement.....*IUSD will be one of the best dental schools of the 21*st century.

IUSD- International Dental Program

In February 2012, the IUSD - International Dental Program (IDP) received approval by the Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) to begin July 2013. The school formally requested and is now authorized to increase enrollment up to 24 IDP students. We will begin with a phase-in of the program by starting with 12 students in year one effective July 1, 2013. Dr. Melanie Peterson is serving as our initial program director and has established our electronic application service through ADEA CAPPID (Centralized Application for Advanced Placement for International Dentists). More updates in January.

New Dental Building and Facilities Update

Facilities changes will continue into 2013 as we prepare for our CODA site visit. Patient lounges will be upgraded on floors 3 and 4 plus the lecture halls in ds114 and ds115 will be totally upgraded beginning in March 2013. Exterior limestone repairs and enhancements will also be made so we will look nice!

First Friday....IUSD Dean's Update December 7, 2012

Thanks to Adam Smith and his facilities team, we are working with the university planners and architects on space requirements for our **new clinical and research building**. Plans call for about 85,000 to 100,000 gross square feet in a new building to be contained in a multi-storied structure with a covered patient drop off area and covered walkway from the dental school to the Vermont garage. We are planning an open atrium too, to link the old buildings with the new. A big step has been taken by IU in that the University has placed this project on the <u>Capital Request list 2013-15</u> (see page 151 School of Dentistry-Phase 1) which has been submitted to the state of Indiana Commission on Higher Education which must approve all projects regardless of funding. **This is huge progress!** Our Building Steering Committee has been assembled and will begin in earnest working with us to identify and invite donors (alumni, friends, foundations etc.) who are willing to step up and make the necessary philanthropic investments (minimal Phase 1 fundraising goal of 10%-- \$3million) of the total \$30million Phase 1 project. Look across Michigan Street to get an idea of how big the new building might be by looking at the <u>new Glick Eye Institute</u>.

General Practice Residency Program

We have made the decision to suspend enrollment for the GPR program effective June 30, 2013. The rationale for this decision is the uncertainty around revenue sources particularly from the Wishard group as the country moves forward with health care reform. The dental school will maintain support for Wishard patients but in an alternative arrangement to be determined in the coming months. Residents currently enrolled in the program will complete the program by June 30, 2013.

Did you know that IUSD now has its own student singing group!
