Second - That said Treasurer is hereby authorized to pledge mortgage notes or other securities & property of the Normal College for the purpose of securing any moneys so borrowed upon such terms as may to the Treasurer pledging the same seem advisable.

Third - That the foregoing powers shall continue until

An agreement made and entered into this day, the 1st day of September, 1907, between the Socialer Turnverein of Indianapolis, party of the first part, and the Normal College of the North American Gymnastic Union, party of the second part; witnesseth:

- as rent for the rooms of the German House herein mentioned, and in consideration of other stipulations herein made, the sum of \$1200.00 per annum, payable in monthly installments of \$100.00 each on the first day of each and every month, beginning with September 1st, 1907. Said Normal College further agrees to pay to said Socialer Turnverein for the lighting of the rooms mentioned herein, the sum of \$100.00 per annum, payable quarterly in advance, beginning with September 1st, 1907.
- It is agreed that said Normal College shall have the exclusive use, except as otherwise provided herein, of the east wing of
  the German House, including the four rooms and gymnasium on the
  first floor, the dressing and bath rooms in the basement, the
  three rooms on the second floor, and the adjoining corridors.
- Said Socialer Turnverein shall have exclusive use of the gymnasium after 3.15 o'clock P. M. for its afternoon and evening classes, and it shall have the use of the assembly room on the second floor for any of its meetings.
- 4. Said Normal College shall have supervision of all apparatus and furniture in the gymnasium and shall keep them in good order. Expenses for repairs of apparatus and furniture shall be equally divided between said parties.
- 5. Said Socialer Turnverein agrees to furnish janitor services, light, heat, and hot and cold water when necessary.
- 6. It is agreed that all gymnasium apparatus, furniture and other property now in use by either or both of said parties shall remain the property of its original owner.
