Campus priorities: Feedback to campus administration	Campus administrators (chiefly Dr. Banta) shared draft administrative goals and received feedback (fall 2009, Jan. 2010).

	Space, quality of the faculty, student retention and graduation, and a collaborative culture.

Action Items to be carried over to 2010-2011:

Action Item(s)	Status
Budget hearings	Budget hearings are conducted annually by the Chancellor. BAC and Campus Planning Committee participation is part of faculty input into campus decision-making.
Resource Planning Committee	This new committee (established spring 2010) will meet bi-weekly in 2010 to 2009. BAC chair has a seat; other participants include chair of faculty council and administrative and dean representatives. Besides input to this committee it is intended to be a conduit of information and discussion back to the BAC.
	RPC is discussing significant changes to assessments (taxes/expenses) and allocation of appropriations (income), within a RCM (responsibility centered management) model but with different formulas (drivers) than in the past.
