## GOVERNING COMMITTEE OF THE FUTURE FABRERS OF AMERICA Washington, D. C.

January 10, 1958

The Governing Committee of the Future Farmers of America was called to order by A. W. Tenney, Acting Chairman, in Room 4643, Department of Health, Education, and Welfare. Those present were: E. J. Johnson and W. P. Gray, Secretary. (Mr. R. E. Naugher was telephoned for approval.)

A discussion was held on the sale of the National FFA Camp property located adjacent to Highway No. 1. This sale had been authorized by the National Board of Student Officers and National Board of Directors. It was decided to authorize Mr. Bob Duncan, Relator, to dispose of the land now owned by the FFA. Such land extends 480 feet in a southern direction from U. S. Highway No. 1, within not less than 70 feet of the new FFA building, and from Dogue Creek in a western direction to include the private road currently used by the FFA.

It was moved by Mr. Johnson, seconded by Mr. Naugher and carried that Mr. Duncan be authorized to complete the arrangements for the sale of the property. Dr. Tenney informed Dr. Spanton of the discussion and decision and he instructed Dr. Tenney and Mr. Gray to call Mr. Duncan concerning the wishes of the Governing Committee. This was done.

The meeting adjourned.
