Dean Rath read a report received from Oscar H. Williams, federal Supervisor of Teacher Training, about his visit of the Seminary in which he provides several recommendations. Decided to send copies of the report to the out of town members asking them for their opinions of the recommendations. At the same time, the latter were submitted to the Administrative Office for their consideration.

In addition, Rath reported that Mr. Richardson has asked for a raise. Decided to reject the request.

Mr. Page's classes were set as follows: Rugby, forty-eight hours; Baseball, thirty-two; Basketball, nine and athletics, nine.

Dr. Alfred Henry handed in his resignation from his position as Anatomy professor. Decided to accept the resignation, however to ask Dean Rath to find out from Dr. Henry the reason behind it.
