AGREEMENT BETWEEN INDIANA UNIVERSITY-PURDUE UNIVERSITY INDIANAPOLIS AND IVY TECH COMMUNITY COLLEGE -CENTRAL INDIANA

FOR THE TRANSFER OF CREDITS EARNED IN THE ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE IN PUBLIC SAFETY FIRE SCIENCE SPECIALTY INTO THE BACHLOR OF SCIENCE IN CRIMINAL JUSTICE PUBLIC SAFETY MANAGEMENT MAJOR

The purpose of this agreement is to provide a framework for the transfer of credits earned in the Associate of Applied Science in Public Safety-Fire Science Specialty at ITCC-Central Indiana to the Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice Public Safety Management major in the School of Public and Environmental Affairs at IUPUI.

The faculty of both institutions have worked together to develop the attached listings of course equivalencies for the associate degree and applicability for the baccalaureate degree. The agreement is in effect for courses taken beginning Spring 2006. This agreement will be reviewed every three years by representatives of both institutions.

All course work taken prior to Spring 2006 will be evaluated by the School of Public and Environmental Affairs faculty to determine transferability of the course work. This agreement, including any modifications, may be reviewed by either institution upon request. Both institutions agree to keep the other aware of curriculum changes as they occur. While both parties to the agreement understand its purpose is to maximize transfer opportunities for students, they also recognize that limits may be placed on courses accepted under the provisions of this agreement, should the student subsequent decide to change to another program not covered by the agreement.
