The minor will be composed of advanced graduate-level courses in psychosocial, institutional and cultural foundations and applications of human diversity, with a particular emphasis on sources of and mechanisms that perpetuate inequality.

Rationale for new minor: (required)

This graduate minor is comprised of three courses that will form a Diversity Science Concentration in the Applied Social and Organizational Psychology Ph.D. program that is currently under review. We have added one more elective (plus an open ended option) to create a Diversity Science minor for graduate students in other IU doctoral programs. The minor should be particularly valuable for students in a variety of disciplines who wish to enhance their foundational training with a scientifically rigorous set of courses in diversity sciences. This minor would be especially valuable for students in health science-related programs who may want an enriched understanding to contribute to the science and practice of health disparities, for example. The minor may also be valuable to students in other social sciences and organizational sciences who wish to specialize in matters related to diversity.
