The following awards are open for nominations now through August 7, 2015. You are encouraged to nominate a colleague or yourself! See below for more details.

The **Gerald L. Bepko Spirit Award** recognizes full-time staff members who through extraordinary service and special (professional, team, or volunteer) contributions exemplify the spirit of IUPUI, strengthening IUPUI by fostering collegiality, cooperation, creativity and innovation toward the end of helping IUPUI become one of the nations' best urban universities for employment and education.

The spirit of IUPUI is demonstrated through one's overall attitude, as well as through acts of loyalty, teamwork, and contribution to the mission, goals, and strategic initiatives of the university as well as the community. The Bepko Spirit Award will be presented to the staff member or team who most exemplifies that spirit.

The **IUPUI Carol D. Nathan Staff Council Scholarship** was established in honor of Carol D. Nathan, Dean of the Faculties. Applicants must be a full-time staff employee of IUPUI with at least two years of service, be pursuing an associate, baccalaureate, or graduate degree at IUPUI; and have completed 12 credit hours at IUPUI with a GPA of at least 3.0. Presentation of the award will be made at the Chancellor's Employee Recognition Convocation in the fall.

The scholarship will be in the amount of \$500 (\$250 awarded at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters), provided the recipient is currently enrolled for at least three credit hours. In order to apply for this scholarship, you must complete the application form and write an essay.

The IUPUI Nan Bohan Community Engagement Staff Award recognizes employees who through extraordinary service and special contributions (e.g., professional, committees, or volunteer) enhance the culture of service and civic engagement on campus and in their communities. The recipient of this award will have demonstrated how they have been civically involved through their roles at IUPUI,

how they have promoted a philanthropic culture among others on campus, and how they have demonstrated a commitment to serving their communities. A \$500 award will be made to the recipient.Â Â Â

The winner of this award should demonstrate merit not based only on the functions of his or her job, but also on extraordinary commitment beyond what would be considered satisfactory levels of job performance.

The **Glenn W. Irwin, Jr., M.D. Experience Excellence Award** recognizes faculty and staff members for service "above and beyond the call of duty." Nominations are open for staff at this time; faculty nominations are welcome in spring 2016. Service for the benefit of the university as a whole or for any of its units which is non-reimbursed and is not specifically job-related will be recognized. All of us are here to do a specific job at IUPUI. The focus of this award is to recognize those individuals whose service activities go above and beyond the responsibilities of their basic job.

All full-time appointed staff who have worked for the university a minimum of 12 months are eligible to be nominated for this award, even if they have been a previous nominee.
