Dean's Update to the IUSD Community

ADA 2018 Survey of Allied Dental Education

Recently released ADA reports summarize information gathered by the *Survey of Dental Hygiene Education Programs*, *Survey of Dental Assisting Education Programs*, and *Survey of Dental Laboratory Technology Education Programs*. ADA conducts these surveys annually to support the accreditation of more than 600 allied dental education programs. The data is available in the more than 120 unique data tables and graphs found in the three reports. Among the highlights is a comparison of first-year enrollment trends between 2006-2007 and 2016-2017. For dental hygiene education programs, first-year enrollment has grown overall in the past 10 years. Meanwhile, first-year enrollment in dental assisting programs increased from 2006-2007 to 2011-2012, then fell to a 10-year low in 2016-2017. Accreditation Work Plan 2018-2020

One of my recent planning sessions on a snowy January weekend was outlining the IUSD accreditation activities ahead of us for the next three years. In a nutshell, they are:

Spring/Summer 2018: Oral Maxillofacial Surgery (OMFS) residency program self-study is underway. Commission on Dental Accreditation (CODA) site visit is September 2018. OMFS is on a five-year cycle. Self-studies for IPFW-IUFW Allied Dental Programs in Fort Wayne (dental hygiene, dental assisting, and dental laboratory technology) are underway. CODA site visit is October 2018. These programs, on a seven-year reaccreditation cycle, transition to IUSD administrative responsibility in July.

Summer/Fall 2018: Kick-off for IUSD pre-doctoral (DDS) self-study and 6 specialty/2 allied dental programs, working toward completion of all self-study documents and exhibits by June 1, 2020. The CODA comprehensive site visit is scheduled for September 2020. Total of 8 programs on a seven-year reaccreditation cycle will be visited.

IUPUI Chancellor Nasser H. Paydar sketched the remarkable scope and scale of the campus's progress during its first 50 years as he presented his 2018 Report to the Community on January 23.
