Indiana University – Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI) is Indiana's urban research and academic health sciences institution located just three blocks from downtown Indy. As the state's third largest university, IUPUI enrolls over 30,000 students in more than 200 academic programs. The institution's alumni account for 85% of Indiana's dentists, half of the physicians, nearly half of the state's lawyers, more than a third of the nurses, and a large percentage of the health and rehabilitation sciences and social work professionals.

Fraternity and Sorority Life at IUPUI has a rich history spanning 88 years and currently is home to 13 chapters, six of which are city-wide. All chapters are affiliated with a national or international organization. The Office of Fraternity & Sorority Life was created in the Fall of 2007 from the growing needs of the fraternal organizations at the institution. The hiring of a full-time staff member and graduate assistant was completed in the Summer of 2008.
