Discussion of possible joint programs with Engineering and Science – Joint MS/MBA Program J. Hassell

Discussion: Joint MS Science and MS Engineering/MBA programs were brought up first. There was some discussion about moving the electives later in the program, but the committee decided the proposed layout was fine. There was a motion to adopt the joint MS/MBA program as proposed and it was seconded and approved with no changes.

Discussion of possible joint programs with Engineering and Science – MS BS Program J. Hassell

Discussion: John explained the three options being discussed for the MS degree identified as options #1, 2, and 3 in his memo. KSB is assuming risk of having enough enrollment in the sections to make the program, 25-30 students would work to start. He thinks there is a large pool of students with GMATs who don't qualify for MBA who would want this program. If we give qualified students credit for MBA core courses, when they started the MBA they would automatically go into elective courses and up the enrollment in the electives.

John, Steve and Jane L sat down and figured out how to teach all of these courses in the building in one semester, but it would be at the cost of the undergrad program who would have more classes outside of the building.

It was decided we need to forecast how many students would be interested in this degree program. It is too late now for Fall 04, soonest we could start would be January 05.

A "Master of Technology" title or MST was discussed again. The program could use V & TM electives as MS electives. John says he needs a product to deliver before he could go forward with the Science & Engineering schools.

Conclusions: The management faculty will look at coming up with a proposed curriculum for the MST and report back to the committee.
