The Bridges to the Doctorate initiative, funded by the National Institutes of Health (NIGMS 5R25GM067592-08), represents a formal partnership between Jackson State University (JSU), an historically black institution (HBCU), California State University-Dominguez Hills (CSUDH) and Indiana University-Purdue University Indianapolis (IUPUI). The purpose of the partnership is to enhance the quality and quantity of underrepresented minority students who are being trained as the next generation of scientists by providing a structured "bridge" between the JSU and CSUDH Master's programs and the IUPUI doctoral program. This program has been named the Edwin T. Harper Scholar's Program in honor of our former colleague, Dr. Edwin Harper.
