# **Campus Profile**

- IUPUI is Indiana's premier <u>urban</u> public <u>research</u> university.
- Offering more than 250 <u>degrees</u> in <u>21 schools</u>, IUPUI is Indiana's most comprehensive university.
- The campus has a health and life sciences focus, with a medical school and a <u>nursing school</u> among the largest in the nation.
- The campus awards degrees from both Purdue University and Indiana University.
- The campus has an annual budget of \$1.2 billion.
- IUPUI offers an affordable top quality education cost of full time undergraduate in-state attendance per year (tuition and general fees): \$6,434; out of state: \$19,668. (<u>Tuition and Fee Estimator</u>)
- The IUPUI Jaguars participate in Division I athletics.
- <u>Indianapolis</u> offers outstanding opportunities for jobs, internships, social, and recreational activities.
- Student housing accommodates approximately 1,107 students in a traditional residence hall, town homes, and Campus Apartments on the River Walk. Off-campus accommodations are also available.



IUPUI is located in downtown Indianapolis just blocks from the state capitol.

#### Research

- IUPUI researchers attracted just over \$400 million in grants and awards for research funding in 2009-2010, a jump of nearly 40 percent over the previous year. - wiew graph
- The campus includes about 100 research centers, including 27 Signature Centers.
- 1667 research grants were awarded in 2008.
- The <u>IU Research and Technology Corporation</u>, located near the IUPUI campus, oversees intellectual property at Indiana University. Through license agreements, patent applications and assisting faculty with startup companies, the IURTC has housed over 30 companies, graduated 13 clients, and created over 370 Hoosier jobs, at an average salary of \$61,000.
- In fiscal year 2009, IUPUI investigators disclosed 94 inventions. Twenty companies entered into license agreements for IUPUI inventions, and 93 patent applications were filed on IUPUI inventions.
- Innovate Indiana is the name for Indiana University's efforts to channel the university's vast resources to strengthen the Hoosier economy. The Office of the Vice President for Engagement is the central point of contact for Innovate Indiana. The office is:
  - Investing in and coordinating IU's economic development activities across the state,

- Turning the innovations of IU faculty into new products, services, and treatments through the IU Research & Technology Corporation (IURTC),
- Connecting the business community in Indiana, the nation, and the world to

# **Civic Engagement**

- Service learning classes, faculty and student participation, hours contributed, and
  community partnerships have increased dramatically as a result of ongoing initiatives,
  including new student scholarships and faculty professional development efforts designed to
  double service learning at IUPUI. In 2008-2009, more than 90,000 hours of service were
  donated to community partners. view graph
- IUPUI has received numerous awards for community service, including being named a "Savior of our Cities" and receiving the President's Higher Education Community Service Award for Excellence in General Community Service.

#### **Education**

- Academic options are comprehensive, offering more than 250 degrees from 21 schools.
- The campus offers degrees from both Purdue University and Indiana University.
- IUPUI has top-ranked programs in schools such as <u>Nursing</u>, <u>Public and Environmental Affairs</u>, <u>Business</u>, and <u>Law</u>.
- Average student/faculty ratio is 19:1.
- Indianapolis campus had a one year retention rate of 74% in 2009.
- The campus is globally engaged through international study, curriculum, and partnerships.
- In 2009, the <u>IUPUI Honors College</u> was founded.
- Honors Professional Admissions Program was launched in 2009.
- The campus offers unique new academic programs, such as <u>motorsports engineering</u>, <u>philanthropic studies</u>, <u>biomedical engineering</u>, and <u>forensic science</u>.

## **Faculty**

- More than 2,500 faculty in 21 schools provide the basis for IUPUI's quality educational programs.
- Over 90% of full-time faculty have professional or doctoral degrees.
- Serious efforts have been undertaken to increase the diversity of faculty. wiew graph
