The Indiana Clinical and Translational Sciences Institute (CTSI) is a statewide collaboration of [Indiana University](#), [Purdue University](#) and the [University of Notre Dame](#), as well as public and private partnerships, which facilitates the translation of scientific discoveries in the lab into clinical trials and new patient treatments in Indiana and beyond.

Established in 2008, the Indiana CTSI was created with a \$25 million [Clinical and Translational Science Award](#) from the [National Center for Research Resources](#) of the [National Institutes of Health](#), supplemented by nearly \$60 million from the state, the three member universities, and public and private partnerships. The Indiana CTSI is a member of a national network of [55 CTSA-funded organizations](#) across the United States. It is funded by NIH grants RR025759, RR025760 and RR025761.
