

IU Dental Student Helps Create New National Association for Ethics and Professionalism

Indiana University dental student Ewelina Ciula, a member of the Class of 2013, represented the IU School of Dentistry in a group that recently met at the University of Southern California School of Dentistry in Los Angeles to lay the groundwork for the creation of a new organization with dental school chapters that will focus on ethics and professionalism development.



The project was sponsored by several national organizations, including the American Student Dental Association. Participating students were from dental schools at the University of the Pacific, IU, Midwestern University, University of Southern California, UCLA, and Virginia Commonwealth University.
