- II. Approval of Minutes**
 - a. Greg Paris, ETSC, motioned to approve Minutes and David Willard, College Republicans, seconded the motion.
 - b. Minutes are approved
- III. Chancellor's Address to Senate**
 - a. IUPUI is world famous for the civic engagement and service learning

 - h. The Master Plan can be found online. We need to make campus easier to move around. IUPUI has too many flat parking garages, purposing building more parking garages. Construction for a lab building will be starting in the spring. Once funding is provided the Cultural trail should be going through campus.

- i. Housing is on the radar. The Board of Trustees are starting to understand that IUPUI needs it. Housing can't be supported by student or government funds. We need to find funds elsewhere.
 1. Tony Greco, LASC, - On the other side of Kelley there is nothing under the breezeway. Are there plans to build there
 2. CB- Building some space underneath where we are located. We are trying to recycle space and utilize it better
- j. IUPUI traded 20 acres of land with Wishard. We will have access to Wishards' new garage that will have 2600-3000 spaces. The sports garage has provided additional parking. We are looking at where the next parking garage will go. \
- k. Everything we do needs to meet the code of the ADA. Tell us if something isn't working
 1. David- There is no uniformity with the access buttons on the doors and the width of the doors
 2. CB- The lack of standardization reflects the time it was done. We've never had the resources to go back and fix it. Wheelchairs have gotten bigger and we need to start noticing places where doors aren't big enough
- l. IUPUI is adding a men's/women's track and field team
 1. Cody Wooten, USG Treasurer,- Heard we will be dropping levels in certain sports
 2. CB-Research shows we can't save money, so no
 3. Rishi Cahdra, Democracy Plaza,- Are there any plans to make the library 24hours
 4. CB- It is possible and can always be asked. We've not found a big demand for it. For us to use the library as 24hour space a \$1 million elevator would have to be built.
 5. Rishi-Focus on study spaces or access to all of the books
 6. CB- Student aren't using paper resources studying that late
 7. Rishi- Can the library limit the amount of space on the 2nd and 1st floors
 8. CB- No, can't effectively close off the other floors. No parking the near the library, which leads to security/ safety concerns. Do think about trying to find another space.
