Teaching Innovations

As many of you are aware, Indiana University now has agreements with several publishers and CourseLoad to provide eTexts and eReader software. Over the past year, more and more faculty have made the decision to adopt eTexts for their course. If you are using an eText, we would encourage you to share your experiences with the FACET office. Each year, the Mack Center for Inquiry on Teaching and Learning provides fellowships to support the scholarship of teaching and learning. Developing a project assessing the pedagogical impact of eTexts would seem to be an ideal project for consideration for a Mack Fellowship. These fellowships are open to all Indiana University faculty members. For those who have already collected data on the pedagogical impact of eTexts, we would encourage you to submit your manuscript for review to our newest journal, the Journal of Teaching and Learning with Technology (JoTLT). This is a peer-reviewed, online journal focusing on the pedagogical effectiveness of using technology in the classroom. The journal is accepting short, Quick Hits style of article, traditional empirical manuscripts, and essays. The first edition of this journal will be available in June. More information about the journal or submitting a manuscript will be forthcoming.
