1. Approval of Minutes from May 2, 2003
 - Minutes were approved as submitted.

2. MSW Action Items
 - Working with Difficult Children course was discussed and was approved with only 1 opposed.
 - Working with Difficult Children course was sent back to the author and the MSW Committee for further revisions.

3. Online aging course and GeroRich Evaluation
 - An Online Aging course (Gerorich) was approved in principle – objectives will be submitted and approved electronically.
 - Margaret Adamek announced that Laura Boyle, University of Indianapolis, is currently working on a non-traditional format for a Certificate in Gerontology – Care Management for working students.

4. Announcements
 - Dean announced a new program that provides faculty incentive to develop online courses and research projects; \$5,000 will be given for each project. Also, faculty will receive \$5,000 for developing grant proposals with a minimum floor amount of \$15,000. Faculty can work together and each member will receive \$5,000. Bill Barton will coordinate all proposals.
 - Del gave an overview of the budget – we are in good shape.
 - The Dean and Marion are working on joint degrees with SPEA and the Law School.
