Frank Windhorst seconded. Motion carried.

Bon Hoblik reported the Federation was seeking some help to paint and general clean-up around the park. Opening of the park is set for April 17<sup>th</sup>. No report on the sewer. All new playground equipment has been ordered. This was at ~~an~~ expense of \$800<sup>00</sup>.

Fred Hoblik made a motion Contendee-clar permits be paid out of the Festival fund. motion seconded. 3 permits from each society. motion carried.

Nominations of officers. - Herman Meier made a motion the nominations be put off till the May meeting. Motion was seconded and carried.
