new business - Brother Fred Hoblt made a motion to raise our flower benefit to \$15⁰⁰ if a member belongs to the Heimata only and to \$20⁰⁰ total (\$10⁰⁰ from each society) if they belong to both the Heimata and the Preussen. Frank Windhorst seconded. Motion carried.

Don Hoblt reported the Federation was seeking some help to paint and general clean-up around the park. Opening of the park is set for April 17th. No report on the sewer. All new playground equipment has been ordered. This was at an expense of \$800⁰⁰.

Fred Hoblt made a motion Bartender-clerk permits be paid out of the Festival fund. Motion seconded. 3 permits from each society. Motion carried.

Nomination of officers. - Sherman Meier made a motion the nominations be put off til the May meeting. Motion was seconded and carried.

With no further business to conduct, the meeting was adjourned at 9:00
