

SLA Technology Committee
March 27, 2009
Minutes [abbreviated]

Guest attendee: Faculty Assembly President Phil Scarpino

Meeting was held in Cavanaugh 003a.

Phil Scarpino attended the SLA tech committee meeting to discuss the school's response to the transfer of the entire Student Technology Fee to UITs, a change from the previous practice of providing each school with a percentage of the fee to use for student-related technology purposes, such as free printing and dedicated computer labs.

An ad-hoc committee of Robert Harris and Kimmaree Murday was formed to create a document to inform students of the status quo, and what might change under the new allocation system. The ad-hoc committee would then send the draft document to the Faculty Assembly president, who upon approval would be listed (along with the Faculty Assembly) as author. Said document was to be placed in prominent places in Cavanaugh, and provided to faculty for distribution to students at will.
