## Vs. the School of Science

- 17 New tenure track faculty in 2006-07 and 2007-08
- If each received a start up package of \$100,000
- $17 \times \$ 100,000=\$ 1,700,000$
- And Liberal Arts would be $\$ 500,000$ in the red rather than $\$ 1,200,000$ in the reserve fund
- And we are growing in our commitments to tenure-track faculty
