### So, what happened at the last Staff Council (SC) Meeting?

The following information comes from the February 15 Staff Council Meeting:

- Vice Chancellor Dawn Rhodes spoke of the reopening of the search for an Associate Vice Chancellor for Human Resources. Juletta Toliver chairs the search with Amanda Shumaker (Dentistry) representing the SC on the committee.
- The IUPUI Police have initiated the **IUPUI Safewalk Program**. The program includes safety escort walks 24/7 to faculty, staff, students, and visitors between 6 p.m. and midnight anywhere on campus. Outside those hours, on-duty IUPUI police and security personnel will provide the walks. FMI 317-274-7233(SAFE).
- Changes are being made to **IUPUI Food Service** based on survey results. Papa Johns will be coming to the Campus Center following spring break to take over the Flat Breads Pizza location. Other changes are expected.
- Lot 1 will be closing on or around March 2. The lot is located directly behind Eskenazi Health and north of the Psychiatric Research building.

- Uday Sukhatme, Executive Vice Chancellor and Dean of the Faculties, spoke to the SC on various issues. Dean Sukhatme will be leaving campus in May to be the Executive Vice President at Pace University. He distributed a handout on the IUPUI Academic Plan's Major Initiatives and Outcomes. He was asked about Purdue University moving to a trimester system and responded that IU is not considering it at this time as we are working on getting students to take summer classes which is essentially a third semester. A farewell reception is planned.
- Academic and Career Development made a <u>presentation</u> on the change in their name and services. The unit is located in Taylor Hall.

- Martha Bulluck, Interim Assistant Vice Chancellor for Human Resources, reported
