Check Your NEW Employee Status Online!

New employees are hired every day and will need a Jagtag for a variety of reasons. To avoid the frustration of an employee visiting the Jagtag Office to get their Jagtag before their hire paperwork (e-doc) is completed, we have created a new process where the employee can check their university status before visiting our office. By visiting the Jagtag website, www.jagtag.iupui.edu (go to Dept/Group Requests), the new employee can enter their UID# and immediately see if they are an active employee in the Jagtag system. If they appear as active, the new employee can come to the Jagtag Office immediately to get their Jagtag. They will need to bring a photo ID as well as the Expense Authorization Form found on our website if your department will be covering the cost of the Jagtag. If they do not appear as active, the new employee should wait 24 hours before checking their status again or check with their supervisor to ensure their hire paperwork has been completed. Employers can check the status on behalf of their employees too.

This valuable service will allow our customers to monitor their status on-line and visit the Jagtag Office to obtain their Jagtag when the time is right! For departments, you no longer have to call our office- just visit our website. It's that simple!

IUPUI is pleased to present the Cutting Edge Lecture Series. Top university professors will engage the community in discussions about rapidly changing fields of inquiry.


