Tobacco (A more detailed list of consequences compiled by Miranda Spitznagle can be forwarded upon request)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Lung Cancer ○ Lung Disease ○ Oral/Throat Cancer ○ Cardiovascular disease ○ Lower infant birth weight ○ Abuse/dependence ○ Risky sexual behavior (youth/teens)/gateway to premarital/teen sex ○ 9,700 deaths annually ○ 14 year reduction in life expectancy ○ Abdominal aortic aneurysm, acute myeloid leukemia, cataracts, cervical cancer, kidney cancer, pancreatic cancer, pneumonia, periodontitis, and stomach cancer, peptic ulcers, erectile dysfunction. ○ For newborns see lower birth weight, poorer lung function, higher incidence of SIDS. Mothers can experience many issues during pregnancy and have a harder time becoming pregnant. ○ Second hand smoke also associated with higher increase in health problems including cancer, problem pregnancies, asthma, cardiovascular disease, etc. 	Retailers cited for sales to minors	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Sales to minors ○ Financial problems ○ \$236 million to US due to second hand smoke-related asthma. Costs Indiana \$9 million. ○ Exposure of children to second hand smoke ○ Increased absences from work and longer illnesses for smokers ○ Smokers incur higher medical costs for employers ○ Smoking increases likelihood that teens will try other drugs. ○ Increased risky behavior such as fighting and engaging in unprotected sex. ○ \$448 million of all Indiana Medicaid expenditures are related to smoking ○
