[J. Manlove] One of the new things that we're doing on campus out of the Student Advocate Office is that we are offering off-campus housing resources for students. I think a lot of students are really wanting to know what resources they have when they're looking for housing off campus, and so, as part of those new resources, we're offering, we are doing an Off-Campus Housing Fair that is going to involve a number of apartment complexes from around the community coming to campus.

Students can meet with them to talk about the specific properties, talk about leasing information, talk about, just get some good information about renting an apartment.

A lot of our students here at IUPUI might be renting an apartment for the first time. Might be out on their own for the first time. We want to help them with that unique opportunity.

It's going to be on April 15th and 16th. That's a Wednesday and Thursday. It's going to be in the atrium of the Campus Center, which is right in front of Barnes and Noble. It's going to be from 10-2. Stop on by. We hope to see you there.

[S. Reed] The Last Lecture and the Chancellor's Convocation will be held on Friday, April 17th at 3pm in the University Place Conference Center and Hotel Auditorium. Dr. Robert Einterz, the co-founder of the Indiana University-Moi University exchange program, will be speaking at the lecture. This program has led to the creation of AMPATH, the Academic Model for the Prevention and Treatment of HIV/AIDS. AMPATH has reduced the rate of HIV infection by addressing poverty issues and by using medical treatment.

The Hip Hop Dance Crew has been busy on and off campus dancing for events like the Jagathon and IUPUI basketball games. Their biggest event of the year, Battleground Zero, is Saturday, April 18th from 7pm-11pm in Taylor Hall. Steven Ding, president of the Hip Hop Dance Crew, has more details.

[S. Ding] April 18 this the Battle Ground Zero. This is the biggest event the IUPUI Hip Hop Dance Crew is going to hold in this year. First of all, we're going to have the battle. It's going to be outside of Taylor Hall at the courtyard. So you will see all those people and music.

Battle Ground Zero has two categories. One is the breaking battle. We're going to have all the breakers from outside of Indiana. Also Indiana State, they're going to come over here and do the battle. Three-on-three battle for \$300 and rock the beat and free-style for \$50. So if you have a crew, you can battle for three-on-three. If you just want to battle individually you battle for rock the beat.
