## Kelley School of Business Evening MBA Policy Committee Minutes 1//17/2007

- 1. November 29th minutes were reviewed and approved.
- 2. Proposal of new \$165 Leadership Development Fee to fund career assessments, slots in Leadership Development Institute, "911 response" for students who lose their job, web portal & maintenance, extra professional coaching, and funding for the enterprises was introduced by Phil Powell. Discussion of this proposal took up the rest of the meeting.

Phil explained the addition of a Carmel Cohort will mean 40-50 more students in the "queue" and a fourth enterprise will be necessary. The Enterprises need more resources, hence the proposal of a new student fee of \$165 per semester starting Fall 2007, providing for:

- A. More online career assessments
- B. Ability to complete leadership simulations run by LDI in Bloomington (possibly run in Indpls).
- C. Extra coaching for X522 class
- D. "911 service" for evening students who lose their job in middle of program
- E. Design web portal for professional development & career services
- F. Funding for the enterprises and addition of a fourth enterprise.

The committee voted unanimously to pass A, B, C, and F. The vote tally for D and E was 5-4-1 with no constitutional majority established. Phil will inform Dean Schmenner of the vote and request an executive decision on the issue.
