Articulation Agreement

- Between Green River Community College works colleges throughout the world. International students choose Green River because of the reputation and the flexibility the school gives for students to complete two years at Green River and transfer to a four-year institution. Bloomington already works with Green River to recruit. The students in the program do not have issues.
 - This agreement is identical to the Vincennes agreement (which is approved).
 This interest has NOT expressed to Green. The UPC wanted to be sure we would have support from the faculty.
 - The Green River students who transferred to IU, their coursework transferred over without the articulation agreement with Kelley. No undergrads have completed a degree, but they should be graduating next year.
 - This agreement is only between IUPUI and Green students. Bloomington campus has a separate agreement.
 - Student needs to meet both the Green River requirements as well as the IUPUI transfer minimum requirements
